# <u>ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS – GRAND RAPIDS PUBLIC SCHOOLS</u> 2025 Roof Replacement Project

#### **BID PROPOSAL**

This project consists of the removal and replacing of the roofing systems at Ridgemoor Park Montessori School with a new 60-mil Fully Adhered Reinforced EPDM Roofing System (flat roofs) over tapered insulation and Architectural Standing Seam Roof System (sloped roofs) with an alternate to go to an Asphalt Shingled Roof System in lieu of the Architectural Standing Seam Roof. *Prevailing wage rates DO NOT apply.* 

Sealed bids, in triplicate, for the Grand Rapids Public Schools 2025 Roof Replacement Project, will be received at Grand Rapids Public Schools Services Building, 900 Union Ave NE, Grand Rapids, MI 49503, attention: Dale Cammenga, Director of Design, Construction, and Renovation on Monday, July 21st, 2025, until 11:00 AM local time. Bids received after this time will be neither considered nor accepted.

All proposals received by the date and time specified above will be opened and **read aloud publicly at Grand Rapids Public Schools Administration building shortly after**.

Grand Rapids Public School requires the following forms to be filled out and submitted with the bid: Family Disclosure Statement, Iran Business Relationship Affidavit, and Non-Collusive Agreement.

## **BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS**

Bidders submitting a Bid for this Project shall have qualifications as follows:

- a. Bidder shall be a reputable, recognized organization with at least ten (10) years successful experience on work of this type and scope
- b. Bidder shall have a license as required by local authorities having jurisdiction.
- c. Bidder shall have the financial resources to complete the scope of work.
- d. Bidder shall have been awarded the Carlisle SynTec ESP Award AND the Carlisle Perfection Award, OR the Holcim Elevate Master Contractor Award AND the Elevate Inner Circle of Quality Award.
- e. Bidder shall be able to meet the timeline for installation.

#### **BID SECURITY - PERFORMANCE BOND**

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security or bid bond in an amount not less than 5% of the Bid amount and shall secure the Owner from loss of damage by reason of the withdrawal of the Bid by a Bidder or by failure of the successful Bidder to enter into a Contract with the Owner if the Bid is accepted by the Owner.

The successful Bidder may be required to secure a Performance, Labor, and Material bond for all contracts equal to or exceeding \$50,000, from a surety company for the full amount of the Contract.
